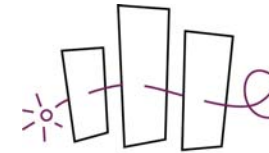

- **April 5th**— Tempe High & Desert Vista Teachers will be handing out teal colored yarn to the students in their 1st hour classes.
- **April 13th/14th**— Teal Flower Campaign! Students at Tempe High & Desert Vista will be making teal tissue flowers at lunch and displaying them in a show of support for victims of sexual violence.
- **April 15th**— Before & After Campaign (RAINN), Students will distribute resource cards provided by RAINN to other high school students as part of a national campaign.
- **April 18th**— Join us at the State Capitol for the kick Off of the National Victims of Crime Week. Peer Solutions will host a resource booth, Peace Labyrinth and participate in the Candlelight Vigil. 3:30p–7:00p
- **April 20th**— National Sexual Violence Resource Center's "Day to End Sexual Violence". Students will be passing out stickers from the NSVRC.
