

## Important Tips for Using SVPEP's Online Database Search Function

Our search page is powered by a program called Reference Manager. While it's great bibliographic software, its web capabilities are still limited. The following tips should help you work around Reference Manager's limitations.

Before you get started, be sure your browser will accept cookies from Reference Manager.

When you open the Search Page, this is what you'll see:

(The default option is Advanced Search because the Quick Search is very limited.)

Enter your search term in the first box: "All Indexed Fields." Change the connector between this box and the next to "OR."

Enter the exact same search term in the second box. Change "All Indexed Fields" to "All Non-Indexed Text Fields". Click the Search button.

**Note:** Although the Hint on the search page says otherwise, authors are *not* included in a search of "Indexed Fields" or "Non-Indexed Text Fields" To search for articles by an author, you must select "Authors" from the search options drop-down list.

To search for combined terms, use "{" and "}" around each of the terms. For example, searching for "{college men} and {prevention}" (in indexed or non-indexed fields) turns up 12 references. Searching for "college men and prevention" (without brackets) produces 0 results.




